



BATTERY CARE AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Never ever opportunity charge
- Once the charger is connected – do not disconnect for a minimum of an 8-hour period
- Never allow sparks or naked flames in the vicinity of a battery
- Keep metal objects away from the battery
- Ensure the charging area is well ventilated
- Under no circumstances should you disconnect the battery before switching off the charger
- Inspect battery leads and plugs
- Always report damaged or faulty batteries and ensure rectification of the fault is carried out before use
- Check the electrolyte levels daily – the electrolyte should be visible 2/3mm above the plates. This is the maximum required
- Only check and top up battery when fully charged
- Use only deionised, demineralised or distilled water
- Only charge the battery once daily with the correct charger
- Always wear protective overalls and goggles
